SCRIPTURE READING: Psalm 135:1-14 (ESV)

¹ Praise the LORD! Praise the name of the LORD, give praise, O servants of the LORD, ² who stand in the house of the LORD, in the courts of the house of our God! ³ Praise the LORD, for the LORD is good; sing to his name, for it is pleasant! ⁴ For the LORD has chosen Jacob for himself, Israel as his own possession. ⁵ For I know that the LORD is great, and that our Lord is above all gods. ⁶ Whatever the LORD pleases, he does, in heaven and on earth, in the seas and all deeps. ⁷ He it is who makes the clouds rise at the end of the earth, who makes lightnings for the rain and brings forth the wind from his storehouses. ⁸ He it was who struck down the firstborn of Egypt, both of man and of beast; ⁹ who in your midst, O Egypt, sent signs and wonders against Pharaoh and all his servants; ¹⁰ who struck down many nations and killed mighty kings, ¹¹ Sihon, king of the Amorites, and Og, king of Bashan, and all the kingdoms of Canaan, ¹² and gave their land as a heritage, a heritage to his people Israel. ¹³ Your name, O LORD, endures forever, your renown, O LORD, throughout all ages. ¹⁴ For the LORD will vindicate his people and have compassion on his servants.
